



Crab Toast

1 stick butter softened
1 jar Old English Cheese Spread
1 ½ teaspoon mayonnaise
½ teaspoon garlic powder
½ teaspoon seasoned salt
7 ounces of crab meat
6 sourdough English muffins

Mix all ingredients together. Split the muffins in half and place on a cookie sheet. Spread the muffins with the mixture and cut into triangles. Each muffin will give you four triangles. Place cookie sheet in freezer for 15 minutes to semi-harden triangles and then place them into Ziploc bag for storage in freezer.

Cooking: Place the frozen triangles on a cookie sheet and broil for approximately 4 minutes until golden brown on top. They work better if they have been frozen first, otherwise, they come out a bit gooey.

Broil until nice and toasty...time may vary but crispy tastes better than soggy!

They keep well in the freezer and allow you to make ahead and only prepare the number you need! Enjoy!
